In 2017, for the first time, Friedens network of food pantries distributed over 1,000,000 pounds of food. This allowed us to increase the amount of food distributed to each person from 12 to 17 pounds. # 2017 Annual Report

Last year, more than 188 individuals, 15 churches, 13 businesses, 2 organizations and 9 grant makers invested financially in our food pantry network. Our volunteer support also continues to increase. *Over 2,500 individuals* served at one of our four food pantries by unloading deliveries, stocking shelves, welcoming community members, and co-shopping in our choice pantries. *Together we have been building ladders of peace throughout Milwaukee since 1978!*
